Health Behavior Assessment and Intervention (HBAI)

Beginning January 1, 2024, CMS has made final a rule that expands the authorizes providers of Health Behavior Assessment and Intervention (HBAI) to include Clinical Social Workers (CSW), Marriage & Family Therapists (MFTs), and Mental Health Counselors (MHCs), and Clinical Psychologists (CPs).

The current Health and Behavior Assessment and Intervention codes (CPT codes 96156, 96158, 96159, 96164, 96165, 96167, 96168, 96170, and 96171) were created by the CPT Editorial Panel during its September 2018 meeting.

Definition of a Clinical Social Worker

- (1) Possesses a master's or doctor's degree in social work;
- (2) After obtaining the degree, has performed at least 2 years of supervised clinical social work; and
- (3) Either is licensed or certified as a clinical social worker by the State in which the services are performed
